

What is the difference between Temperate Controlled Units and Standard Drive Up Units?

There is NO protection from temperature fluctuations or protection from humidity or anything that can cause mold or mildew in Standard Drive Up Units.

If you are storing for any long period of time, please understand it is your responsibility to check on the contents of your unit.

Our Indoor Units are cooled in the summer and heated in the winter. These units help protect contents from temperature swings that can cause damage to wood, electronics, books, works of art, plastic or wax items, and cloth items. Please be very aware this when choosing a unit type.

For example, mattresses do not store well in Standard Drive Up Units.

The difference between the 2 types of units is like storing your belongings in a back bedroom of your house compared to storing your belongings in a typical unattached garage. Please take this into consideration when choosing what unit you need.

We do not insure your property, we encourage everyone to contact their insurance agent and speak with them regarding getting coverage on your own for your contents.
